

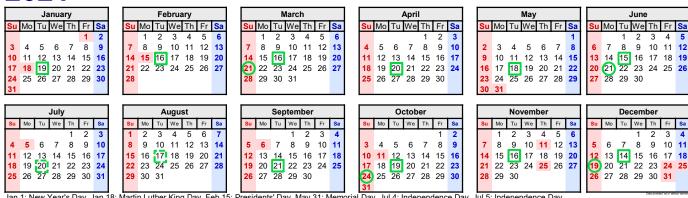

Now: using a congregation member's laptop to stream services



Need a laptop with enough power to do video encoding, live streaming, and light video editing



Current system is fine, but we'd like to have a dedicated system for use that can be shared and used for other things around the church too

Proposal

- Purchase an HP Pavilion 15t Laptop approx. \$1100
 - Intel Core i7-1065G7 (up to 3.9 GHz, 4 cores)
 - 16 GB RAM
 - 512 GB M.2 SSD
 - Nvidia GeForce MX250 2GB graphics processor for encoding video
- Lots of brands available, but we get a small discount on HP laptops through their non-profit organization program; HP is a reasonable tradeoff between performance and price
- Purchase a USB microphone for Pastor's use in video Bible studies and meetings
